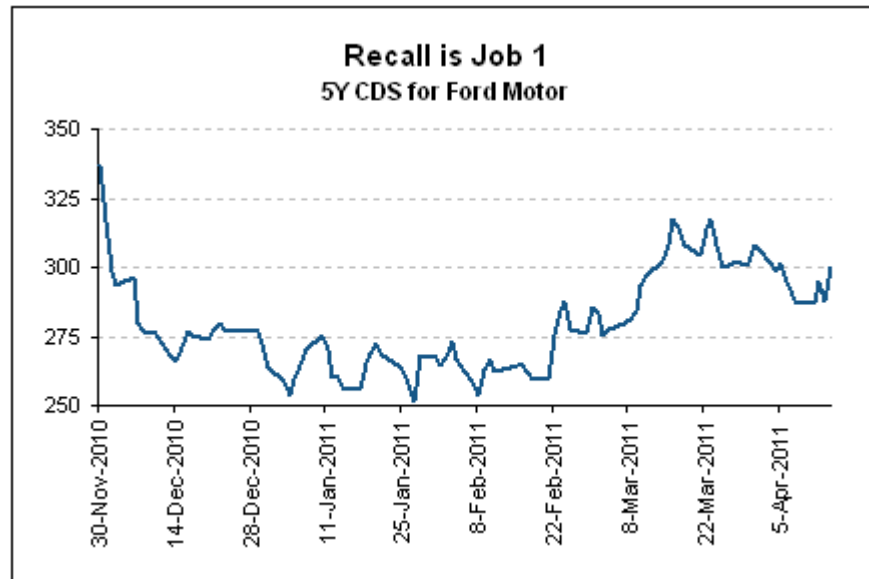


Chart of the Day



- 5Y CDS for Ford is 12 bp wider today following an announcement that the company was expanding its recall of F-150 pickup trucks
- Earlier the company recalled 144,000 of the F-150 over concerns about inadvertent deployment of front-seat airbags. The expanded recall affects 2004-2006 model years of the F-150 and the 2006 Lincoln Mark LT which will reach about 1.2 million vehicles. Ford has thus far issued a recall every month this year (the original F-150/airbag recall was in Feb)
- The F-Series truck is the best-selling truck in America and was the nation's top-selling vehicle of any type last year.
