2024 Forecasted Weights

We review the weights of markets included in the Markit iBoxx ABF Pan – Asia indices in September, and the final weights are updated on 31 October every year.

Quarterly weight forecasts are calculated and published in March, June, September, and December. From 2022, the December market weight forecast will be ceased. The weights will be calculated and published in March, June, and September.
